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Kathie was a tireless champion of mental health issues while in the legislature and every year since her tenure as a state legislator. She was the sponsor for Medicaid for Workers with Disabilities legislation in the House. While in the legislature Kathie also served on the Idaho Self-Determination Task Force which created the self-direction option under the developmental disability waiver.
