The Idaho State Independent Living Council (SILC) is partnering with the Idaho Centers for Independent Living (CILs) to host public meetings across Idaho. The SILC and the CILs serve Idahoans across disabilities and lifespan. The SILC and CILs are gathering information to develop a three year (2020-2023) State Plan for Independent Living (SPIL) that addresses Independent Living needs across Idaho. The purpose of the meeting is to:

- Provide an overview of the duties and responsibilities of the SILC, as they relate to systemic advocacy and education.
- Provide an overview of the duties and responsibilities of the CILs and the core services they provide in our communities.
- Inform the public about the State Plan for Independent Living.
- Help us determine how to allocate resources to improve opportunities for people across disabilities and lifespan to live in their community with the supports they need.
- Help us understand how the local community is serving people in regards to housing, transportation, healthcare, education, job training, employment, recreation, community access and any other issues pertaining to people with disabilities living independently in our communities.
